

AMAZING ARIZONA & LAS VEGAS (Updated 7/2/18 with airline pricing)

February 11-21, 2019 (11Days)

*Winter Escape to Arizona, a region of sunny skies and scenic splendor!
From Western lore, landscapes of breathtaking grandeur,
& thrilling outdoor adventures, this trip has it all!*



DAY 1 – (Fairfield Glade, TN – Phoenix & Tucson, AZ): Escape the cold of winter traveling to warm and sunny Arizona! Your hotel for the next **three nights** is at the **La Posada Lodge**, located in the foothills of the **Santa Catalina Mountains in Tucson, Arizona**. Get to know your fellow travelers with a “Welcome Margarita” at the hotel; relax by the pool and dine at your leisure this evening.

DAY 2 – (Tucson, AZ): Bring your camera as you visit the **Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum**. It is said that a trip to this museum will turn your idea of a museum inside out! Experience the Sonoran Desert, which includes a zoo, botanical garden, natural history museum, aquarium, and art gallery, all in one place! It is rated #2 in all of Arizona, right behind the Grand Canyon. DAY 3 – (Tucson – Tombstone, AZ): You’ve seen it in the movies; you’ve seen it on TV but until you go there, you’ve not really seen it – “The town too tough to die!” Travel to the wildest town of the West, **Tombstone, AZ**, home to the shoot-out at the O.K. Corral. The American West is still alive here and your visit begins at the original **Boot Hill cemetery**. Then mosey along the boardwalks, have lunch and enjoy this historic town. Join in the western fun this evening at a genuine dude ranch, **Tanque Verde Ranch**, for an outdoor **Cowboy BBQ Dinner**. **Fill your plate with mouth-watering ribs or steaks and listen to live western entertainment.** **(Breakfast, Dinner)**

DAY 4 – (Tucson – Phoenix): On the way to Phoenix, stop at **Casa Grande Ruins National Monument**, one of the most mysterious of Southwest’s Indian ruins! Arriving in Phoenix, It’s time to “strum some fun and experience the world through music” during your visit to the **Musical Instrument Museum**, rated the #1 attraction in Phoenix and one of the top museums in the U.S. Displaying more than 6,000 instruments from over 200 countries, instruments from all over the world come to life through technology that enables you to see and hear instruments in their original cultural settings like no other museum in the world. It’s an unbelievable experience! **Lodging for the next two nights is at the Drury Inn, Happy Valley, AZ. (Breakfast, Lunch Voucher)**

DAY 5 – (Phoenix Area): Cruise on the **Dolly Steamboat**. Experience breathtaking scenery and wildlife as you cruise Canyon Lake at the foot of the Superstition Mountains. Enjoy a buffet lunch prior to departing to the **Queen Creek Olive Mill for a tour and tasting**. Return to your hotel to get ready for a fun evening with a beautiful sunset panoramic view of Phoenix. **Dinner is included tonight at Rustler’s Rooste**, a mountaintop saloon and steakhouse, bustling with **country-western entertainment!** **(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

DAY 6 – (Jerome – Clarkdale – Sedona): Heading north into high country, visit **Jerome**, a historic mining town that clings to the slopes of Cleopatra Hill, high on Mingus Mountain. It went from a roaring copper mining boom town to Arizona’s largest ghost town. Artists moved in and now it is Arizona’s most unique art and history destination. Enjoy the galleries and shops and then head to Clarkdale; you have a train to catch! Board the **Verde Valley Railroad**.

Enjoy first-class accommodations- munching on hors d'oeuvres and sipping champagne, as you travel through the Verde River Canyon, enjoying dramatic views not accessible by cars. A short drive takes you to Sedona, your home for the **next two nights at the Hampton Inn, Sedona, AZ. (Breakfast)**

DAY 7 – (“Sedona” – Named “#1 Most Beautiful Place in America!”): This morning is at your leisure but perhaps you would like to take an optional shuttle to **Tlaquepaque**, Sedona’s Arts & Crafts Village. Fashioned after a traditional Mexican village, it is the heart and soul of Sedona. This land is called “Red Rock Country” and is surrounded by red-rock monoliths, all of which you will see on your off-road adventure with **Pink Jeep Tours**. Where the pavement ends, the fun begins as your jeep wrangler heads toward Schnebly Hill’s towering red rock formations and picturesque views. Your jeep will climb through winding canyons and over rocky trails, with your expertly trained guide at the wheel. **(Breakfast)**

DAY 8 – (GRAND CANYON – One of the Seven Wonders of the World!): Travel through Oak Creek Canyon’s Scenic Road on your way to the Grand Canyon. **Lunch is included in Cameron at the Historic Trading Post**, known as the best place to shop for authentic Native American souvenirs. Arrive at **Grand Canyon National Park** and explore the canyon’s 25-mile Desert View Drive, along the South Rim. Stop at “Desert View” for your first views of the awesome Grand Canyon; climb the historic “Watchtower,” the highest point on the south rim. Continue on to **Grandview Point** for more breathtaking views. Before exiting the park, stroll around **Grand Canyon Village**. **Lodging this evening is at the Holiday Inn Express in Tusayan**, just outside the park. **(Breakfast, Lunch)**

DAY 9 – (Tusayan, AZ – Las Vegas, NV): “Get Your Kicks on Route 66” - Travel to Seligman, located on the original “Mother Road” to **Angel & Vilma’s Gift Shop**. Here you will find a treasure trove of Route 66 memorabilia! **Lunch is included at Calico’s** in Kingman, AZ. Departing for Las Vegas, cross the **Hoover Dam Bypass Bridge**– “America’s Newest Wonder.” This is the 2nd highest bridge in the US and the 14th highest in the world! If parking is available, we will stop at the Visitor Parking Lot and a short walk on the bridge will provide an excellent photo op of Hoover Dam. Welcome to Nevada and to Las Vegas, “the entertainment capital of the world!” **Lodging for the next two nights is at Harrah’s, located on the Vegas strip. (Breakfast, Lunch)**

DAY 10 – (Las Vegas): Entire day and evening is at your leisure! Your travel documents will contain information regarding optional local tours and current shows. **(Breakfast Buffet)**

DAY 11 – (Las Vegas – Nashville – Fairfield Glade, TN) – Fly home today, surrounded by new friends and filled with great memories of your wonderful winter escape to Amazing Arizona and Las Vegas.
