Let period, costumed guides and craftsmen re-create life in Colonial Williamsburg. It is an experience to be cherished!

As you stroll along the streets, feel the excitement of "Christmas Past."

Christmas in Colonial Williamsburg, with all of its authentic buildings, people in period dress recreating the lives of the Patriots, is likened to history books coming alive before your eyes and you become a part of that era!

THEN, Depart Colonial Williamsburg and travel through time to the world-famous Greenbrier Resort.

Nothing compares to its Christmas elegance and beauty!

Day 1 Journey back into history as you follow the Appalachian Mountains to Wytheville, VA for an **included lunch at the historic 1776 Log House Restaurant**. On the way to Charlottesville, VA, watch out for "Reindeers" that have been known to accompany the Ladies Club Travelers during the holidays! A **buffet dinner is included** this evening at the **Wood Grill Restaurant**. **Lodging: Comfort Inn-Monticello, Charlottesville, VA - (Meals Included today: Lunch, Dinner)**

Day 2 Following an **included breakfast**, visit **Montpelier**, the lifelong plantation home of Dolley and James Madison, the 4th President of the US, Father of the Constitution, and Architect of the Bill of Rights. Montpelier is a National Historic Landmark! Close by, experience American history that tickles your taste buds. **Lunch is included at the 1784 Michie Tavern** in "The Ordinary," where servers in period attire will dish up your midday meal. Continue on your way to **Colonial Williamsburg**, "The World's Largest Living History Museum," for a celebration of Christmas Past. For nearly a century, Williamsburg was the social, cultural and political center of our new nation. To re-create the early American life, all 88 public buildings have been restored to their original state. Christmas traditions have been handed down over generations. As you stroll along the streets, feel the excitement of "Christmas Past" while period costumed guides and craftsmen re-create the colonial style of life. You will visit the old colonial city that has been carefully restored and rebuilt to recapture the period from 1699 to 1780 to let you experience 18th century America...its architecture, atmosphere, its food, dress and, of course, Christmas customs and decorations. Each Christmas, the exhibition buildings, homes, and shops are adorned with wreaths, cones, garlands, fruit and other beautiful decorations constructed from natural materials. Enjoy your relaxing visit to Colonial Williamsburg with **3-nights lodging at the Woodlands Hotel**, which is adjacent to the Visitor Center, from which the **free shuttle bus operates throughout Colonial Williamsburg**. Your **multi-day pass** allows you to leisurely explore all of Colonial Williamsburg for the next two days!

Discover life in days gone by as you step back in time to encounter local residents, from artisans and trades people to militiamen and ordinary citizens. Visit authentically restored buildings like the Governor's Palace, Bruton Parish Church, and Colonials homes; discover a wide array of activities and demonstrations as you please. There are many special events that you may want to consider attending that are not included in your pass (i.e. concerts, carriage rides, lunch or dinner in the taverns, holiday walking tours). Please consult the **official website: colonialwilliamsburg.com prior to your arrival** and click on PLAN – Explore the events calendar. You can book those activities, not included in your tour price, prior to your arrival. If you have trouble booking any event, you may also call: 1/800-447-8679. **Dinner at Christina Campbells is included** in your tour but perhaps you may want to have lunch/dinner at one of the other taverns or Williamsburg Inn or Lodge as well. **Lodging: Woodlands Hotel, Colonial Williamsburg - 3 nights - (Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch)**

Day 3 Following an **included breakfast** in the hotel lobby area, enjoy **Colonial Williamsburg in all of its 18th-century glory!** See the **orientation film**, which is shown continuously in the Visitor Center prior to beginning your visit. The entire day and evening are at your leisure! **(Meals included: Breakfast)**

Day 4 Following an **included breakfast**, the entire day is completely at your leisure to enjoy Christmas in Colonial Williamsburg. This evening, a group **dinner is included at George Washington's favorite tavern for dining, Christina Campbell's.** **(Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner)**

Day 5 Enjoy an **included breakfast** before traveling to the **world-famous The Greenbrier Resort** at White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia. The Greenbrier is spectacular at anytime during the year but there are no words to describe the wonder that exists during the Christmas Holidays. Busy elves have trimmed over 300 trees, hung over 120,000 lights, strung miles of greenery, wrapped 20,000 gifts, and given poinsettias a coat of fairy dust. Relax by the fireplace or listen to the carolers sing. Everything is so beautiful and grand! **Lodging: The Greenbrier - 2 nights (Meals Included: Breakfast)**

Day 6 **Breakfast is included in the main dining room.** Dress code applies: resort casual (collared shirts for men) No fitness nor sports apparel are permitted. The day is completely at your leisure. There are culinary demonstrations, hotel tours, bunker tour (fee), swimming pool, movie theatre, bowling and even a casino. Other activities, such as carriage rides and bunker tours, do have a fee. **(Meals Included: Full Breakfast in the main Dining Room!)**

Day 7 **Breakfast is included in the main dining room.** Dress Code applies! Travel this morning to Beckley and the Southern coal fields of West Virginia on your way home to Tennessee. Driving through the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains, you will arrive in Greeneville, TN. **Lunch is included** at the **General Morgan Inn**, the "crown jewel of Greenville." You will be overwhelmed by its Christmas beauty and what a special way to conclude your adventure to "Christmas Past" and along the way, making new friends and memories that will last a lifetime. **(Meals Included: Full Breakfast in the main Dining Room, Lunch at the General Morgan Inn)**
