DAY 1 – SEDONA – Depart for Phoenix, AZ to begin your journey. Overnight in **Sedona**, surrounded by red rock cliffs, buttes, and mesas, to make this city the “#1 most beautiful place in America!” **Lodging: Hampton Inn, Sedona**

DAY 2 – OAK CREEK CANYON – CAMERON – GRAND CANYON – Admire beautiful **Oak Creek Canyon's** immense rock formations that seem to change hue with every turn in the road. On the way to the Grand Canyon, stop at the historic **Cameron Trading Post** for an **included lunch**. Get ready for some soul-stirring sights as you make your way to the grandest canyon on Earth – **The Grand Canyon – One of the Seven Wonders of the World!** Drive along the South Rim on Desert View Drive, stopping at the Watch Tower and Grand View Point for unbelievable photo opportunities. **Lodging: Premier Grand Canyon Squire Inn, a mile south of the park's entrance. Included Today: Breakfast & Lunch**

DAY 3 – LAS VEGAS – Driving to Vegas, venture off the interstate to a portion of Arizona's original **Route 66**. Visit **Angel & Vilmas "Original Route 66 Gift Shop"** in Seligman to “get your fix on Route 66!” **Lunch is included at Calico's** in Kingman before crossing over “America's Newest Wonder,” the **Hoover Dam Bypass Bridge**. Get ready for bit of cultural shock as you take a **cruise down the Las Vegas Strip and downtown area** before checking into your hotel, which is just a short 10-15 minute cab ride to the central strip. A **seafood buffet dinner** is included this evening at the hotel. This hotel has everything and anything that you could want – good reasonably priced restaurants, movies, even bowling alleys and, of course, you may want to try your luck in the casino! **Lodging: South Point Hotel, Casino & Spa, Las Vegas – Included Today: Breakfast, Lunch & Seafood Buffet Dinner**

DAY 4 – ZION NATIONAL PARK – Journey to **Zion National Park**, Utah's National Treasure, where abundant beauty stops visitors in their tracks and leaves them gaping in awe. Utah's oldest and most famous National Park is enchanting and “spectacular” is uttered time and time again while viewing the statuesque monoliths. Picture yourself surrounded by a brilliant green canyon, set against the backdrop of sheer red cliffs with waterfalls, and rock formations described as thrones, steeples and cathedrals. You will see it all on a **90-minute tour aboard Zion's open-air sightseeing tram**. But first, enjoy a **light lunch in the lodge's Red Cliff Restaurant**. Depart Zion National Park for Bryce Canyon and tonight, enjoy a **buffet dinner at “Cowboys Buffet & Steakhouse.” Lodging for two nights: Best Western Plus Grand Hotel at Bryce Canyon – Included Today: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

DAY 5 – BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK – Words just aren't available to describe the beauty of **Bryce Canyon National Park**, famous for its “Hoodoos.” Explore the park, stopping at scenic overviews along the way. See the famed “Pink Cliffs” of Bryce Canyon and the natural orange and red colored formations called Hoodoos, one of the most spectacular scenic wonders in the world. Indians described Bryce as “Legend People Who Have Been Turned to Stone!” They were referring to these eerily shaped stalagmite-like pinnacles and pillars that rise up out of the ground (Hoodoos). It is unbelievable! Afternoon and evening are at leisure – a perfect time for hiking or perhaps horseback riding! **Included Today: Breakfast (Over)**

DAY 6 – AMERICA'S SCENIC HIGHWAYS – ARCHES NATIONAL PARK – A memorable day is before you on one of America's most spectacular roads, "The **All-American Scenic Byway 12.**" Travel the "Crown Jewel" of America's scenic highways through **Grand Staircase Escalante National Monument**, filling your windows with views of a beautiful desert palette of cream and rose colored Navajo sandstone. See dramatic cliffs, high mesas, streams and deep canyons along the way. Stop in Boulder at **Anasazi State Park Museum**, viewing ancient Indian ruins and then climb up and over Boulder Mountain, reaching altitudes over 9,000 feet with incredible views. Enter another scenic byway, running alongside Capitol Reef National Park. **Lunch is included at Duke's Slide Rock Grill.** Sightsee in **Arches National Park**, the world's largest concentration of natural sandstone arches with surreal landscapes. **Lodging for two nights: Comfort Suites, Moab, UT – Included Today: Breakfast & Lunch**

DAY 7 – DEADHORSE POINT STATE PARK – CANYONLANDS NATIONAL PARK – Enjoy one of Utah's most spectacular state parks, **Deadhorse Point State Park**, one of the most photographed scenic vistas in the world! Towering 2,000 ft above the Colorado River, the overlook provides a breathtaking panorama of **Canyonlands National Park**. Learn the legend of Dead Horse Point before departing for the fun, little town of Moab with leisure time for lunch and shopping. This evening, enjoy the Canyonlands National Park in a very different way: with "**Canyonlands by Night and Day!**" Start with a **cowboy-style dinner** overlooking the Colorado River. **Board your boat** with a knowledgeable guide and once darkness settles in, lighting will illuminate the canyon walls. There will be lights, shadows, music and stories that will bring history to life on the walls above the river. **Included Today: Breakfast & Dinner**

DAY 8 – MONUMENT VALLEY – PAGE, AZ - LAKE POWELL – You must have been here before; you recognize it all! You grew up seeing this ancient wonder as the perfect backdrop for dozens of classic Western films, TV series and commercials. **Monument Valley**, in the Navajo Nation, contains some of the most recognizable, natural geological formations in the world, thanks to Hollywood. Many western movies were filmed here. Enjoy **lunch at historic Goulding's Lodge**. Then sit back and enjoy your beautiful **panoramic tour of Monument Valley with your Navajo Indian guide in a 4-wheel-drive vehicle**. Leave Utah and re-enter Arizona for a **boat cruise on Lake Powell to Antelope Canyon**, one of the most photographed slot canyons on Earth! End this great day with a delicious **dinner and music at Gone West Family Restaurant**. **Lodging: Hampton Inn, Page, AZ – Included Today: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

DAY 9 – JEROME – PHOENIX – Head to **Jerome!** Enjoy leisure time for lunch and shopping in Arizona's liveliest ghost town before driving to Phoenix to prepare for tomorrow's journey home. **Lodging: Drury Inn, Happy Valley, AZ – Included Today: Breakfast**

DAY 10 – HOMEWARD BOUND – Transfer to the airport for your return flight to Tennessee, reminiscing about the unbelievable, head turning wonders you've seen on your awesome Fairfield Glade Ladies Club vacation to America's Canyonlands of the Southwest.
